

STUDENT DRESS AND GROOMING CODE

Personal appearance should not disrupt the educational process, call undue attention to the individual, violate federal, state, or local health and obscenity laws or affect the welfare and safety of the student or his/her classmates.

1. Clothing or grooming style which is disruptive to the school environment, dangerous, profane or advocates racial, ethnic or religious prejudice is not permitted on campus. Chains of any kind are not allowed, or oversized belts.
2. Clothing advertising drugs, alcohol, tobacco or displaying profanity or sex is not permitted on campus.
3. Any apparel, jewelry, accessory, notebook, personal belonging or manner of grooming which, by virtue of its color, arrangement, trademark, or other attribute, denotes membership in gangs is prohibited on campus, (LUHS Board Policy 6.6-3, 5136).
4. Footwear must be worn at all times.
5. Clothing that is too revealing, such as crop tops, halters, sheer, see-through or form fitting tops, tube tops, backless tops, spaghetti straps, short shorts, or short skirts, are not allowed. **The midriff must be covered.** Clothing that does not cover undergarments are not allowed. **Shorts are to be no higher than mid-thigh. Skirts are to be no higher than mid-thigh with the measuring point being the highest open point of the skirt hem.**
6. Pants must fit at the waist and be able to stay on without being held.
7. Hats, if worn, are to be worn with the bill straight forward (to the front) and are to be removed upon entering any classroom or office.
